Key Passages: Jeremiah 17:7-8, Mark 4:1-20, Galatians 5:22-23

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- There is a symbiotic relationship between being blessed and trusting God (You can trust Him)
- What is "fruit"?
- Mark 4
 - Jesus tells a story and this time explains what it means
 - It's a passage about our hearts
 - "The condition of our hearts determines the fruit in our lives" Doug Kempton
- Fruit = the word of God lived out in our lives
- God is speaking all the time
 - Are you listening?
 - He speaks through...the Bible, nature, circumstances
 - When God speaks its a seed BUT not all seeds bear fruit
- · The soil of our hearts
 - (The path) Some of us have been hurt -> bitterness, anger, self protection (hard heart)
 - (Rocky soil) Unhealthy attachments (anything we cling to other than God...the rocks have to be removed)
 - There will be trial when God gives us a word (spiritual warfare)
 - (Thorns) Crowded soil...too busy, cares of the world crowd out what God has said
 - (Good Soil) Everything has been dealt with
- Types of fruit
 - Fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)
 - Joy as opposed to gloom, peace as opposed to turmoil, kindness as opposed to being rude, goodness as opposed to willful sin, gentleness as opposed to short tempered/overbearing, self controlled as opposed to impulsive
 - Sometimes it's about your demeanor or character
 - Other times it is about actions lived out
 - Bearing fruit is about doing the very thing God has called you to do
- Hearing from God and then responding to his word in our lives = bearing fruit

- 2. What is the state of the soil of your heart right now? Which soil from Jesus' parable do you relate to the most right now and why?

- 4. What are the things that you are tempted to cling to or lean instead of God?
- 5. Which of the fruit of the spirit is the greatest challenge for you right now? Why is that? How is God leading you to grow?
- 6. What is a word that God is calling you to live out in your life right now?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
