Key Passages: Ephesians Philippians 3:17-20, Acts 1:1-2, 1 Timothy 1:5

Main Ideas

- Recap: 1) Know Christ 2) Press On 3) Forget the Past (called to throw off everything that hinders us) 4) Keep in Rhythm
- Community -> Helps us thrive in our relationship with God
 - We sometimes underestimate community
 - There is a great amount of learning that happens from doing life together
- Philippians 3:17-20
 - Join in imitating me (Paul is not being prideful or saying I'm the next best thing to Jesus)
 - · He knows the importance of having a living example
 - The early church had no new testament or persona copy of the Bible
 - we need people who are good examples of what it means to follow Jesus
 - Godly people are signs pointing to the living Christ
- What does community do for us?
 - 1) It Ignites our Passion
 - · A passionate faith os contagious
 - Something in me should provoke others to chase after God
 - Others faith/pursuit of God creates a spark in us (Gerald and his friend at the library)
 - 2) Community shows us the way
 - Acts 1:2...all that Jesus taught and did
 - Acts 4:13 the disciples had "been with" Jesus
 - Jesus taught/showed the disciples the way
 - If we don't know how to pray -> find someone who knows how to pray and watch/listen to them
 - We don't have to learn it all on our own or figure it all out by ourselves
 - 3) It ignites and builds our faith
 - 1 Timothy 1:5
 - Paul was saying "You've been around the real thing"
 - · Here at Grace we get to be around people older than us, peers, and people younger than us
 - God wants to do great things in and through us and has uniquely gifted us so that we need each other
- 3 ways of learning (triangle)
 - Information = reading books, hearing info, taking notes...we put this one on a pedestal
 - Imitation = finding someone that I can apprentice and learn from watching how they do it
 - Immersion = experience, dropping in an environment
 - We need a balance of ALL of these things
- We are called to pursue Jesus together each with our own unique gifting and talents

- 1. Have you ever had someone in your life that you were imitating (in following Jesus or in something else)? What was it like? What did you learn?
- 2. Talk about a time when someone else or a group of people ignited your passion for following God
- 3. When was a time when you learned about a specific portion of your relationship with Jesus through someone "showing you the way"?
- 4. What are the areas in your life right now where you need someone to show your the way?
- 5. Of the 3 ways of learning (information, imitation, immersion) which one is most natural/common for you? How is God calling you to build more balance in the way your learn?
- 6. How is God challenging and growing your idea of what it means to be in community?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or message?
