Key Passages: 2 Kings 5:-1-14 (Read the rest of the chapter too), Ephesians 2:10, Isaiah 50:11, 1 Peter 3:15, Romans 12:21

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- Where is God asking you to step out in faith and take a risk?
 - Could be a conversation
 - Maybe a career or job change
- We are God's workmanship, created to do a good work that he has prepared for us (Ephesians 2:10)
- 2 Kings 5: CONTEXT
 - Divided kingdom (Israel and Judah)
 - The people drift further and further from God
 - God brings chaos to get them to return to Him (Isaiah 50:11)
 - If you try to do things in your own way or in your own strength your life will be chaos
- 2 Kings 5:1-14
 - There is something for is to learn from all the characters in the story (It would be good to read all of 2 Kings 5)
 - How am I just like these people?
- Who is the servant girl?
 - · Most likely lived in a village made up of just her extended family or at least people who all knew her
 - Raids were meant to strike fear into the villagers to prevent resistance
 - She was taken from everything she knew and essentially became a slave
 - Who could blame her if she became bitter or turned away from God?
- In v3 the servant girl shows us
 - FAITH...He would cure him (it was not conditional)
 - LOVE...Would that my lord (A desire for what's best for others)
 - FORGIVENESS...A desire to bless the ones who curse you
 - The sign of forgiveness is your heart's desire to bless the one who hurt you Doug Kempton
 - The servant girl brings the blessing and models the teaching of Jesus (Luke 6:28,35)
 - God is kind to us (ungrateful, evil) and we are called to be kind to others
 - COURAGE...sharing the reason for hope with gentleness/respect
 - 1 Peter 3:15b
 - Tell them why we have hope, not judgement
- Romans 12:21
 - The servant girl overcame her oppressor
 - We transform those around us and bring light into darkness
 - 2 Kings 5:17 -> the servant girl's enemy became her brother

Questions (Feel free to use all of these, some of these, or none of these)

- 1. What does it mean to you to have unconditional faith? How would it play out in your life?
- 2. What has God taught you about forgiveness?
- 3. How is God calling you to practice forgiveness and to bless those that may have hurt you?
- 4. What is a situation or relationship that God is calling you to share the reason for your hope with gentleness and respect?
- 5. Where is God asking you to step out in faith and take a risk
- 6. What is an area or circumstance that you need to have courage in?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or message?
