Key Passages: Ats 4:32-37, Acts 9:26-27, Acts 11:22-26, Acts 15:39-41

Main Ideas

- · Our unsung hero this week is: Joseph...who has his name changed to Barnabas
 - It was a common to practice to give someone a new name
 - To reinforce or solidify something about them
 - Bar-Nabi (Barnabas is just an english version of that name)
 - Bar = son or daughter of
 - Nabi = generous, encourager, exhorter
- What is your new name? Son of _____, Daughter of
- Barnabas was someone who came alongside and called great things from others
 - He was a cousin or Mark, and came from wealth
 - Owning land was imoortant...so selling his would have been more risky than now
- It also would have been very encouraging to the early disciples (someone supporting them and their ministry) Acts 9:26-27
 - After Saul (name changed to Paul) is converted from a murderer to a follower of Jesus he wants to join the disciples
 - But the disciples were afraid (Paul had murdered followers of Jesus before converting)
 - But at a critical moment in church history...
 - Barnabas stands up for Paul
 - He believed in Paul when no one else did
- Acts 11:22-26
 - The disciples were scattered from Jerusalem but they took their faith with them
 - Gentiles were becoming believers...
 - Barnabas saw the gifting in Paul and invited him to Antioch to pour into the church and some ways launch some of Paul's church planting ministry
- Acts 15:39-41 (Paul and Barnabas really became ministry partners)
 - Paul and Barnabas disagree about bringing Mark along
 - Barnabas encourages the one who needs it most (Mark)
 - He chooses Mark (generous and encouraging)
- Barnabas live up to his name and is a hero because he came alongside others
- **Asking the Lord for your new name or encouraging someone you know with a new name**
 - Ask the Lord what your new name should be or a word/name he wants you to give someone else
 - Try searching google for the bar-____ names (try searching the greek word for ____
 Encourage someone in your c-group, family friend group with a new name
