Key Passages: John 4:1-26, 2 Kings 17 (if interested in the back story), 2 Chronicles 16:9

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- There is a connection between worship and missions
- John 4:1-26
 - Context
 - Jesus and disciples walking from judea to Galillee (about 70 miles)
 - Had to walk through Samaria....bad blood between Jews and Samaritans (2 Kings 17)
 - Samaria had a whole new religion
- Jesus did not concern himself with social expectations
 - Going through Samaria at all
 - Talking to a woman alone (a woman who had a bad/scandalous reputation)
 - How often do we disengage with someone because they offend us or make us uncomfortable?
 - Are we willing to move towards people who are on the margins or who might be "scandalous"?
- To the woman: living water = moving/flowing water
 - She would have been excited...but skeptical
 - What are you taking about Jesus?
- When Jesus gets to a heart issue, she tries to change the subject (let's talk about church/worship
- There is a connection between living water and worship
- v23: worship is no longer about a place
- The only way to access living water is through worship
- What is worship?
 - So much more than songs/singing (that leads us to worship)
 - Worship = an active appropriate response to the invitations of God in your life
 - Obedience = worship, participating in IMPACT = worship (sometimes..."Stop doing that" or "Don't go there"
- What does it mean to worship in spirit? with all that you have. with your whole spirit and self
- What does it mean to worship in truth?
 - Growing to know who God is (theology matters)
 - Being real/honest/transparent about who and where we are (like in the Psalms)
- When we worship living water wells up in you and flows out of you
- What does this have to do with missions?
 - everything
 - "Mission is not the ultimate goal of the church. Worship is. Mission exists because worship doesn't" John Piper
 - We are called to make worshippers of nations...to go and tell others...as purveyors of truth

- 1. What is your definition or worship? What does worship look like specifically in your life?
- 2. When was a time that worship lead to living water welling up in you and flowing out of you?
- 3. How are you doing at worshipping God with all that you have? How is God calling you give more?
- 4. Share a time when a wrong view of God or yourself prevented you from responding to His invitation
- 5. How has your worship lead to mission in your life or your community?
- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
