Key Passages: Matthew 5:13-16, Acts 2:42-47, Exodus 22:21

- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- All 6 Essentials are critical to your growth and walk with God (they are all present in Acts 2:42-47)
- They are snyergistic and they work together and grow one another
- Matthew 5:13-16 (INFLUENCE)
 - Sermon on the Mount
 - Jesus' teaching turned the current world view on it's head...and it creates a radical shift in thinking for us
- Nothing seems to radical at first glance...
 - You are: Salt of the earth and Light of the world
 - Salt = mostly used as a preservative, valuable commodity, people were paid in salt —> we are preserving the world and pulling it towards morality
 - Light = helps to see something, bringing things into focus -> we help people to see Jesus more clearly
- God calls Israel...Exodus 9
 - A kingdom of priests and a holy nation (priests carry the presence of God)
 - God put them in perfect place to reach the nations (trade/travel all went through this "land bridge" where God had placed his people) Exodus 22:21
- But the people if Israel became consumers of God
 - They forgot that God's blessing was given for them to bless others
 - So God took the promise land away from them (they were exiled to other places)
 - If we're not intentional and paying attention we can become consumers of God
- When we are salt and light it changes everything...home/workplace/community
- God has put us in the perfect place to have influence for him
- 3 Challenges
 - 1) Stay connected
 - Most people in church don't have non-christian friends
 - We have to be intentional about relationships with people who don't know God
 - Who are the people you need to move towards?
 - 2) Be an inviter
 - "come and see" was the invitation on the new testament
 - Overcomer movie, Sep. 8th picnic, Tauren Wells concert, Big Band Christmas
 - What can I invite someone to?
 - 3) Pray for an opportunity
 - Every morning before your feet hit the floor
 - "Lord, would you give me an opportunity to have one conversation with someone about you."

- God has called us to be salt and light and he has placed in a perfect place to influence people for Him
