Key Passages: 1 Samuel 8:19-22, 1 Samuel 16:13, Acts 13:22

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- In 1 Samuel 8:9-20 the people of Israel cry out for a king
 - They were promised one but had judges (normal people who went back to normal jobs after that fulfilled the purpose/season God had for them) up until this point
 - 1st Lesson: A good thing for the wrong reason is a bad thing
 - Israel wanted a king so they would "be like the other nations"
 - They get what they ask for and a tragic story begins...
- King Saul: Taller, better looking than anyone else
 - 1 Samuel 10:1 God gave him another heart (the holy spirit
 - Saul had an opportunity to succeed...He had ALL that he needed and so do we
 - We are chosen and God gives us everything thing for life and godliness
 - But Saul's achilles heal was FEAR (he hid when he was to be officially made king)
 - Then Saul acted out of fear (the wrong reasons) again when he sacrificed (a good thing) before Samuel got there -> 2nd Lesson: Fear is a dangerous motivator
- Fear keeps us from doing what we should and causes us to do what we shouldn't
- 1 Samuel 16:13 Samuel anoints David and "the spirit rushed on him"
- Similarities between Saul and David
 - Neither really wanted to be king, neither sought it out, both chosen by God, both given the Holy Spirit
 - · But David was a "man after God's own heart"
 - He had a passionate pursuit of knowing God, wanted to please him, wanted to please Him
 - This prompted David to be fearless
- Goliath: was a huge guy that was taunting the people of Israel
 - Saul and Israel were afraid (Saul was supposed to be the champion to face Goliath)
 - Then Saul entrusts the future of Israel to a BOY
 - David did what Saul was supposed to do...he would be the king that Saul was supposed to be
- The antidote to fear is love
 - Perfect love casts out all fear
 - Perfect love is only found in God and his son Jesus
- God has choses us and empowered us
 - God searched for you and found you
 - He has given all you need to overcome
 - David knew this truth and Saul did not

- 1. When was a time you did a good thing for the wrong reasons? What did you learn through the process?
- 2. When has a desire to be like others affected you in a negative way?
- 3. What does it mean to you that God has given everything you need? How does that affect the way you think and live your life?
- 4. What's the thing in front of you (like Goliath) that you are scared of?
- 5. Share a time when you conquered fear? How did you rely on God in the process?
- 6. How does the truth that God has chosen you empowered you affect your heart and mind?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
