## Main Ideas

- Foundations for this series: 1) There is absolute truth 2) The Bible is true & trustworthy 3) The Bible us authoritative
- Is Jesus the Only way?
  - Don't all religions lead to the same God?
  - Is Christianity the only true religion?
- · How you answer this question drives how you live and organize your whole life
- 3 Possible positions (worldviews)
  - 1) Pluralism = one's own religion is not held as the exclusive source of truth
  - 2) Inclusivism = while one set of beliefs is absolutely true, other sets of beliefs have some element of truth
  - 3) Syncretism = combining, blending or merging different religious faiths
    - This was the achilles heal of the people of God
    - We also have the tendency to add things to or blend other things with the Gospel
- 2017 Barna Group Study: 75% of Americans identify as Christians —> 55% said if you're generally a good person you go to Heaven —> 80% (and 65% of regular church attenders) believe there are other non-christian religions that lead to Heaven
- 4th World view...Exclusivism = the doctrine or belief that one particular religion or belief system is true
  - There can be some truths in other religions (all truth is from God)
  - It can feel egotistical, exclusive and intolerant but how we feel about it doesn't decide if it's true or not
- 3 Questions
  - 1) Did Jesus claim to be the only way?
    - John 14:1-6...YES
    - · This is the primary distinction between Christianity and other religions...others are behavior based
  - 2) Did the Apostles say Jesus was the only way (YES...Acts 4:12, 1 John 5:11-12)
  - 3) How do we know Jesus' words are true?
    - He fulfilled over 300 specific/detailed Old Testament prophecies
    - And ultimately because he rose from the dead...if he did this all his claims are true. If he didn't then its all a farce
    - The apostles were willing to lay down their lives or the risen jesus
- We have been entrusted with a great truth
  - Go into the world and share the truth
  - Not about being exclusive and keeping people out BUT Inviting people in
- Being good enough is not enough. Jesus is the way, the truth and the life

- 2. Was there ever a time when you held one of the 3 positions Doug mentioned? Explain
- 3. How have you come to believe that Jesus claim to be the way, the truth and the life is in fact true?
- 4. If Jesus is the only way, how is God asking you to think about the way you engage others?
- 5. Do you believe that you have nee entrusted with a great truth? How does this affect the way you live?
- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
