

Sunday, March 8, 2020 - "You Asked For It - Week 10 - Abdu Murray Interview"

Key Passages:

Main Ideas

- Post-Truth Culture
 - One that elevates feeling and preferences over facts and evidence
 - Post modernism = there is no objective truth
 - Post truth = Truth exists but feelings matter more
 - Adam and Eve were first post-truth people (they wanted to be God instead of be with God)
- Freedom vs. Autonomy (these are not the same)
 - Autos = self... accountable to no one
 - When preferences clash who wins?
- Pantheism world view (Pan = All, theos = god -> "All is one and all is god")
 - Hunduism, buddhism, scientology are all about the escape from pain
 - · Life is an aillison, somewhere inside of you is the divine spark...we are all god
 - Karma...what we say matters
- Is the Bible the inerrant, inspired word of God?
 - What does this mean? thousands of early copies with a few variants
 - In all that it teaches and affirms the Bible is inerrant (that doesn't mean it doesn't have some copying mistakes)
 - It is inspired (not "dictated" by God)
 - You hear the style/personality of the authors
 - God uses background of the people writing to communicate and convey certain things
- Do I have to believe in a literal 7 day creation without taking liberties with the Bible?
 - What does "literal" mean (Jesus: I am the door..he literally is the door to the Father, but is not a door on hinges)
 - · We can interpret the Genesis creation story in different ways
 - Day = yom
 - · Could mean a 24 hour day or could mean an "age"
 - "A slow miracle is still a miracle" Abdu Murray (the Bible doesn't talk about the mechanisms for creation)
 - The Bible leaves options open (earth is a few thousand years old, earth is billions of years old
- Why is God so angry in the Old Testament and loving in the New Testament?
 - God redeemed Adam and Eve immediately
 - To be a God of love He has to be a God of justice/judgement
 - He constantly took the people of Israel back after they broke their covenant with Him
- If God is love, why is there so much bad stuff in the world?
 - This questions is not academic, it is always personal
 - · Morality can't be defined by human opinion because we have gotten it wrong so many times
 - Things aren't moral/immoral, people are -> objective/transcendent morality has to be rooted in a person -> God
 - God is a transcendent/objective moral being (above human opinion and thought)
 - Free Will
 - If we have no ability to reject God, we have no ability to accept Him (the only way love is possible
 - People can choose to do what God wants or not (evil)

- 1. Have you wrestled with any of these questions or others that Abdu answered? How has God spoken to you?
- 2. Why do you think we can sometimes elevate feelings/preferences over truth?
- 3. What do you think are the ramifications of God defining morality instead of us?
- 4. How do you process the difference between freedom and autonomy?
- 5. What has your journey with suffering been like? What has God taught you about suffering or evil and His own goodness?
- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
