

Queen Esther

Bible Story: Queen Esther (Based on book of Esther)

Key Verse: “Who knows? It’s possible that you became queen for a time just like this.” Esther 4:14b

Bottom Line: We can speak up for what is right no matter what the cost.

Basic Truth: I can trust God no matter what.

1. Watch the Queen Esther episode of the Super Book series on RightNow Media (link on gracewired.com/familyresources)

2. Discuss SuperBook- Queen Esther

Ask your family the following questions:

- Joy wants to nominate her new friend into the leadership club, but the leader doesn’t want a person with challenges. Why do you think Joy is afraid to stand up for her new friend?
- Do you think Queen Esther was afraid to stand up for the Jews and ask the king for help? Why was she afraid? (Answer: There was a rule that no one could go before the king unless the king asked for them to come.)
- Have you ever been afraid to stand up for someone who needed your help?
- Make it personal by sharing with your kids a time that you were afraid to stand up for someone else.

Review the key Bible verse: “Who knows? It’s possible that you became queen for a time just like this.” Esther 4:14b

Encourage them to stand up for someone who needs their help. It is possible that we were created for such a time as today, to stand up for a friend.

3. Pray

- Gather kids to pray
- Prompt them to think of someone they should stand up for
- **Pray:** “Dear Lord, thank you for using the story of Esther to teach us to be courageous and stand up for someone who needs our help. Each one of us is thinking of someone who needs us to stand up for them. Help us to trust you no matter what and stand up for our friend. Amen”
