Key Passages: 1 John 4:7-21, John 15:13, Romans 5:8

Main Ideas

- We have to keep it really simple Love God. Love people
- Complete this sentence: I love _______
- · Advent has a 2 fold meaning
 - Jesus' birth
 - · His coming again
- 1 John 4:7-21
 - Our love is to be focused on God and on one another
 - We often think of love as something physical. The world can shape our way of thinking
 - We sometimes live in our fears (but love is different)
 - 23 times in the Gospels: Love one another
- Love requires 3 things
 - Love requires DISCIPLINE
 - The discipline of Jesus' mother Mary
 - To be in the situation she was in and still say "Lord, I am your servant. I will do what you ask"
 - Love requires DYING
 - Love reconciles relationships (before you give your gift reconcile with your brother or sister)
 - · Who do we need to be reconciled to?
 - John 15:13: Not about being right all the time, not being the center of attention
 - Jesus dying on our behalf and calling us to do the same for others
 - Love requires **DEMONSTRATION**
 - Love needs to be acted out in deed and in truth
 - Even to those who we don't want to love
 - · Who are we extending our love to
- Romans 5:8..Who do you need to love?
