Key Passages: Mark 4:35-41, Mark 3:10, Mark, 4:1, Mark 4:39, Mark 5:15, Mark 5:36, Mark 6:41, Mark 6:49-51

Main Ideas

- Jesus' mobile classroom (the boat)
 - The disciples get a pop quiz
 - The couldn't turn back, Jesus was asleep and in fact had prepared to be asleep
 - Jesus could be "sleeping" in the middle of out storm
- Don't you care that we're about to die?
- We want to know when we have to activate our faith
 - Jesus says "Your faith should always be on and active"
 - "Faith, phone, wallet, keys" - Kevin Dupree
- v41: Who is this man?
 - They had a glimpse but they were still wondering
 - Both non-believers and believers have this question
- Mark 4:11-12
 - Secrets of the Kingdom of God
 - People who truly seek to understand the kingdom
 - He will reveal God's truth
- In a perfect world, we would trust that people are who they say they are
 - Have to look at character
 - Have to look at actions
- Jesus' actions should lead to faith..."You still don't have faith?"
- Who is this man?
 - He is a **Healer** (Mark 3:10) - Physical healing and spiritual healing
 - He is **Knowledge** (Mark 4:1) - Divine knowledge, John 1:14
 - He is **Peace** (Mark 4:39) - In the midst of every storm
 - He is **Freedom** (Mark 5:15)
 - He is **Hope** (Mark 5:36) - Hope in hopeless situations
 - He is a **Provider** (Mark 6:41) - Our needs not necessarily our wants
 - He is **Alive** (Mark 6:49-51)
 - He is **Remarkable**
- He is all of these things for each of us

1. When was a time when you felt like Jesus was "asleep" in the midst of one of your storms? What did you learn?
2. What does it look like for you to have your faith on and active in all situations?
3. What have you learned about God and seen Him do that inspires faith?
4. Of the answers to the question "Who is this man?" which is the hardest to believe for you personally?
5. Of the answers to the question "Who is this man?" which one do you relate to or hold on to the most?
6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
