

Sunday, March 14, 2021 - "Remarkable - Week 9: The Temple and A Fig Tree" - Doug Kempton

Key Passages: Mark 11:12-25, Isaiah 56:1-12, Jeremiah 7:1-11

- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- The clearing of the temple was about God's expectations for his people and religious leaders
- The temple was to be a House of prayer for all people
 - Most who would have heard this would have had it memorized (Isaiah 56:1-12)
 - God's vision for the temple was that it would be a place where outcasts, foreigners, and gentiles could come to serve Him and minister to Him
 - God's chosen people were called to be priests to all nations, showing them the living God
 - But Jesus called out the leaders...they filed the space for gentiles at the temple with stuff
- Jeremiah 7:1-11
 - Has my house become a den of robbers?
 - · God is a God of justice, integrity, holiness
 - · The people of Israel did not repent
 - · Repent is to turn in a different direction
 - Jesus knew the system was broken
- The Fig Tree is a teaching metaphor
 - · Jesus isn't cleansing the temple he is condemning it
 - The sacrificial system is finished
 - When he talked about no stone left standing he meant he was remaking the temple
- "When our religion does not align with God's vision, He will clean house." Doug Kempton
- What is Fruitfulness?
 - It's about JUSTICE
 - Protecting the most vulnerable
 - Moved to action against unjust systems and for people that are oppressed
 - It's about EXPANDING THE KINGDOM
 - Seeing people come to faith
 - · Taking ground from the enemy
 - It's about INTEGRITY
 - · Seeds of rebellion are always born in hypocrisy
 - What we say matches what we do
- How are we to be fruitful?
 - · We know what's required of us and it's not about trying harder
 - It's about LOVE
 - Love God -> Love people
 - · We become more gracious and merciful
 - The presence of God in everything we do
 - · Listen to and learn from people who love Jesus
 - It's about ABIDING
 - We have a tendency to wander
 - Minute by minute, 24/7 requirement
 - · Apart from God we can do NOTHING
