Key Passages: Ephesians 2:8-10, Ephesians 2:11-16, 19-22, James 2:1, 8-9, Luke 14:13b-14, Philippians 2:4

- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- For we are God's
 - We belong to Him (individually and corporately)
 - · Biblical precepts and promises apply of us individually and also as an organization
- Ephesians 2:10 You are God's workmanship
 - Poema + God's poem/art
 - You are created to do something specific (there is a general call make disciples, serve HIs kingdom, love one another and a more specific call for each of us to play a part in those things)
- We are a mosaic striving to live like Jesus
 - We are a mosaic = broken pieces -> put together to make a beautiful work of art
 - Does diversity really matter? YES
 - Why is the mosaic so important? BECAUE IT'S BIBLICAL
- God's mission is to make us one...He sent his Son so all nations can ONE
- Ephesians 2:11-16, 19-22
 - There were 2 groups bitterly divided (this was the audience of this passage)
 - We live in a deep divided time
 - He himself is our peace
 - Jesus unites us
 - · He breaks down the barriers
 - You ARE one
 - Not "Are we one?"
 - We are called to live into the oneness that Jesus made possible
- "Our witness to the world is our uncommon, supernatural, radical unity" Doug Kempton
- As long as we teach Jesus what difference does the mosaic make?
 - James 2:1, 8-9
 - The sin of partiality
 - Inviting some, excluding others (we are called to see EVERYONE the way that God sees them)
- Luke 14:13b-14
- Grace cannot do the good works God has prepared for us to do until we are a fully-engaged mosaic
- Sometimes the mosaic is hard
 - We like being comfortable
 - There is a wide array of personal preferences
 - We are called to be others-focused
 - Philippians 2:4 Put down what we want to refer others
- Striving to live like Jesus
 - To cooperate with the work of the Holy Spirit
 - Not to earn salvation and God's love
 - You have to participate with God
 - Becoming more and more like Jesus

- 1. Why is the mosaic at Grace important to you? What have you learned about God through being a part of a diverse community?
- 2. How has God used uncommon, supernatural, radical unity to be a witness through you or to you?

- 4. How is God calling you to grow in preferring others? What personal preferences is he calling you to put aside?
- 5. How can you participate in the mosaic outside of Sunday mornings?
- 6. How are you doing at cooperating with the work of the Holy Spirit in your life? How is God calling you to grow?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
