Key Passages: Proverbs 4:12, 1 Corinthians 12, 1 Corinthians 13:4-7, 1 Corinthians 14:1-2

Main Ideas

- We are a Word and Spirit church
- We are a Word church
 - Proverbs 4:12 The Bible is our standard (for right and wrong)...our final authority on all matters of faith
 - The Bible is true, trustworthy and the very word of God...and it all points to Jesus
- Why word AND Spirit
 - People have abused the word of God in the past
 - Knowing a lot of scriptures does not equal spiritual maturity
 - The Spirit reveals who Jesus is and what He has done through the word
- Hear and Obey
 - We are called to heed the word -> life change
 - Not only hear/read but do what it says
- 1 Corinthians 12, 13, 14 (We believe all spiritual gifts are still active today)
 - Spiritual gifts are critical in the church
 - They are always for the common good (benefit the body of believers)
- When it comes to spiritual gifts
 - "All have some. None have all," Roc Bottomly
 - No gift is more spiritual or holy
 - The church is a body..."the big toe is indispensable"
- A more excellent way (The way of love)
 - Spiritual gifting is not the same as godly character
 - "Spiritual gifting without maturity and self-awareness will always lead to abuse" Doug Kempton
 - You can't abuse someone and love them at the same time
- There can be a cycle: Desire the Spirit (and gifts)-> Experience the Spirit -> Abuse the Spirit -> Prohibit the Spirit
- We have to focus on loving God and loving people when exercising spiritual gifts
- A few gifts that can he harder to understand
 - Tongues (2 types)
 - 1) Speaking in a language that you don't speak and haven't been trained in (Acts 2: disciples at Pentacost)
 - 2) Prayer language to God (some have it, some don't...not a "merit badge")
 - We don't do it from the front because it can be confusing and disruptive
 - Healing "When it comes to healing, He often does. Sometimes He does not. But either way, he is Good" Roc Bottomly
 Prophesy (1 Corinthians 14:1)
 - A word of knowledge from God to/for someone else...for the building up and encouragement of the body
 - The feeling like you need to call someone or reach out to someone and it's "perfect timing"
- We need all of us fully engaged in the obeying the word and in our spiritual gifting to see Grace be all that it can be

- 2. How are you doing at hearing the word? How are you doing at obeying the word?

- 4. When was a time that you experienced tongues, healing or prophesy? What do you learn from it?
- 5. What would it look like for you to be fully engaged in the Word and in your spiritual gifts?
- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
