Main Ideas

- A Culture of Prayer
 - Where everything we do is birthed in prayer, covered in prayer, and celebrated in prayer
 - We are still on a journey as a church
 - Lord, Teach Us to Pray by Andrew Murray
 - Read this book (Pastor Doug's recommendation)
 - Disciples asked this of Jesus...Jesus was dependent on God through prayer
 - "Prayer is not a drudgery. Prayer is not a burden. It is a divine privilege."
 - God inviting us into relationship with Him
 - You talk to him, He talks to you
 - Doug's story about going to KAA (Kids Across America)
 - A "bad" sermon lead to hundreds of kids placing their faith in Jesus
 - The movement of the Spirit unleashed by all of that prayers that were prayed
 - Luke 6:12-13, 17-19
 - · Jesus modeled a way of life and of ministry (Jesus prayed all night before selecting his disciples)
 - A way we are supposed to move before we act
 - Are there some decisions that require us to stay up all night in prayer?
 - Jesus models
 - 1) Prayer 2) Community 3) Ministry/Action
 - · Some times we flip this order
 - A culture of prayer starts with an earnest desire to pray
 - · Hearing God's voice is a discipline to be learned
 - Luke 6:18
 - "How you listen now determines how you hear later" Doug Kempton
 - Practical application and advice
 - Be vigilant in prayer (pray about everything)
 - Pay attention to your disposition (consolation or desolation in your spirit?)
 - Invite others to the process
 - Trust in Jesus (not a game, His ways our better than ours)
 - Pray for others more than yourself (soften hearts towards them, hear God's voice)
 - Pray the Scriptures over your family, your friends, and your enemies
 - How can you join culture of prayer?
 - Prayer tab on the Grace website
 - Pre-service prayer
 - 9:30 AM church wide prayer (text: 930PRAYER to 313-777-8270...periodic prayer texts)
