Key Passages: Ephesians 1:3-14

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- The City of Ephesus
 - A very dark city
 - Worshipped the goddess Artemis (temple was one of seven wonders)
 - Port city: prosperous, "anything you wanted you could get"
- But the apostle Paul shares the gospel of Jesus and the city/world changes
- Who is hearing and seeing the word of God because you're in their life?
- Ephesians 1:3-14 3 Phrases
- We are REDEEMED
 - We have a new identity
 - Members of the family of God
 - Our calling is to move towards Christ everyday...be redeemed
 - Who in your life needs to know God personally
- We are MARKED
 - Sealed by the Holy Spirit
 - We are called to live as someone marked by God
 - The greatest adventure of your life is following Gd together
- Eulogetus (to the praise of His glory)
 - This is where the term eulogy comes from
 - Live a life so marked by God that your eulogy is about the praise of God's glory
- The spirit of artemis is still around today
 - Trying to destroy us
 - Our battle isn't against flesh and blood
 - We put on the armor of God everyday and lives as the redeemed and marked by God

- 1. Have you ever been a place that felt "dark" like Ephesus? What did God reveal to you?
- 2. Who is hearing and seeing the word of God because you are in their life? What is your relationship like?
- 3. Who in your life needs to hear and see the word of God through you? How can you engage in that process?
- 4. In your own words, what does it mean that you are redeemed? How does this affect the way you think about yourself and your life?
- 5. How has following God been like an adventure for you?
- 6. What does it look like for you to put on the armor of God daily?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
