Key Passages: Psalm 46, Exodus 14:14

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- 1500s: Bubonic Plague
 - 1/3 of the population in Asia and Africa died
 - Martin Luther stayed in the city he lived while people fled to the countryside (started a makeshift hospital in his house)
 - He wrote "A Mighty Fortress Is Our God" after reading Psalm 46
 - It was written in times of peril
- · God does not waste anything...He redeems our pain and sorrow and He brings beauty from ashes
- Psalm 46 was meant to be sung and proclaimed..God is with us!
 - It was written while the city of Jerusalem was under siege
 - They were cut off from food and water while surrounded by their enemy
- God IS...
 - All powerful, never weak
 - OUR refuge (He is for us)
 - OUR strength
 - Ever present with us..we need to take hold of this truth
- Therefore...WE WILL NOT FEAR
- Theme of the river...all throughout the scriptures...bringing us life and nourishment
- Come behold the works of God
 - A call to remember
 - Not just all powerful BUT Emmanuel God with us (v1: God is very present, v5: in the midst, v7/11: Lord of Hosts with us)
- If you have God, you have victory (no matter what you're going through)
- v10: Be Still
 - Word means cease or stop
 - Not about a "spiritual retreat"
 - Stop doing things in your own strength, stop trying to do what only God can do
 - Exodus 14:14 ("watch me fight for you")
 - The gospel is an example of this (it's a free gift)
 - We can't do anything to get it to to earn it
- · Where do you need to cease?
- Where do you need to be silent and let God fight for you?

- 1. What does it mean to you that God is your refuge and strength?
- 2. When was a time when God was your very present help in time of trouble?
- 3. What are the works of God that He is calling you to remember right now?
- 4. In what situations or circumstances do you think God is asking you to cease? To be still?
- 5. What are you trying to do in your own strength that only can do?
- 6. How is God calling you to be silent and allow him to fight for you?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this passage or sermon?
