Key Passages: Philippians 2:19-30, Ephesians 2:10, Romans 12:10

Main Ideas

- 4 Keys to healthy relationships
 - Humility
 - Honor
 - Encouragement
 - Prayer
- Philippians 2:19-30 (no commands/no instructions)
- Paul expresses the immense value of 2 men: Timothy and Epaphroditus
- Timothy
 - No one like him, genuinely concerned for the welfare of the Philippians
 - A lot of people were doing things for the wrong reasons
 - Like Timothy is how we are to walk out the christian faith
- "For I have no one like him"
 - NOT that he was any better than anyone else
 - But Paul is utilizing **The Power of Particularization** (Ephesians 2:10)
 - See gifting/passion/how God made someone...calling out these things in other
 - We should all do this saying... "I have on one like..."
- Romans 12:10
 - Out-do one another in showing honor
 - No one like you
- Doers of the word and not just hearers of the word → the power of particularization
