Key Passages: Matthew 28:16-20

- · Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group
- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- · Matthew 28:16-20
 - · Jesus is about to ascend into Heaven
 - · His final words are to commission his disciples
- · You and I are commissioned with Jesus
 - To be disciples and to make disciples
 - Not the great MISSION but the great COMMISSION (we do it WITH God)
 - · What are we doing with our resources?
 - · Are you willing to do what God wants you to do?
- · We are sent, we are commissioned
- · All authority belongs to Jesus
 - · The King commissions us
 - · To do what He has called us to do
 - Are you submitted to the authority of Jesus?
- When we are on mission with God —> meaning + purpose
- · The commission starts with submission
 - · We are called to submit every part of our lives to Jesus
 - · You can't be a disciple until you submit and surrender...not because you have to, because you get to
- What do we do? (v19)
 - · Not 4 different activities
 - · Make disciples...this is how:
 - Go (we are all called, everyone)
 - · Baptize Bring people into the family, outward expression of becoming part of the family
 - · Teach not just preaching, teaching one another community
- Are you willing to go wherever God sends you?
- · Not do's and don't's...learning to love God and love people
- · All authority....the great commission..."I am always with you"
 - The commission is in the middle of these statements from Jesus
 - · How and where is God calling you to go?
