Key Passages: Romans 8:17-25

Main Ideas

- · There is a meaning to success or achievement when we go through a process to get there
- Romans 8:17-25 There is a caveat to our adoption into God's family and Kingdom -> SUFFERING
- · Sufferings of the present time
 - · Then: financial loss, physical suffering, outcasts
 - Suffering for following Christ
- Suffering —> from "God do for me" to "God be with me"
 - Enduring
 - Suffering reminds of eternity
- Glory to be revealed (this is eternal)
 - The glory of the Lord
 - · Not out own glory but God in us
 - The sun is what makes the moon special
- · Creation groans for its complete restoration
- · We know there is something wrong i this world (sin)
 - · Division among people
 - We make decisions for our own glory
- The now and the not yet
 - · We are adopted/saved through Jesus
 - · But we wait for the completion
- · God's people groan in hope for our full redemption
- "I have found truly joyful christians only in the Bible, in the underground church and in prison." Richard Wurmbrand
- · You are not odd because you struggle. You're family. Fikre Prince
- · Pain and suffering should remind us that there is a great physician making all things new
- · This present suffering is making way for a future glory
