Key Passages:

- Feel free to read the passage(s) out loud as a group

Main Ideas

- We can end up accomplishing what we want for our life instead of God's will for our lives
- We need to become comprehensive men and comprehensive people
 - · Jesus was the lion AND the lamb
 - This requires vulnerability
- The quality of our lives is determined by the quality of our emotions
- · We don't know how to engage in conflict
 - · It becomes volatile
 - · We need what Jason calls "Courageous Transparency"
 - · We need to express ourselves without the fear of being condemned
 - This allows us to appropriately deal with conflict
- Sometimes we hear someone saying something else we're doing wrong instead of listening to their heart
- We are products of forgiveness so we extend forgiveness
- When we hold on to anger and bitterness, we can't focus on what we need to do in the moment

- 1. How have your emotions affected the quality of your life, positively or negatively?
- 2. What does it mean to you to be a comprehensive person?
- 3. What have you learned about navigating conflict in your relationships?

- 5. How is God calling you to "run into the battle" for your thoughts and your heart?
- 6. How does your understanding of Jesus shape your understanding of your emotions?
- 7. What is God inviting you into as a result of this interview?
