Key Passages: Acts 1:6-14, Romans 1:21-22, Amos 5:21-23, Revelation 3:20

## Main Ideas

- · What is the new normal for church?
- The last decade has seen a major shift in culture and hostility towards biblical values (Romans 1:21-22)
- Baseline understandings
  - capital C church = The whole church, the called out ones
  - lowercase c church = this particular body of believers (Grace)
  - If it's true for an individual/group it's true and applicable for us as a church (we are called to something unique as Grace Community Church)
- · Acts 1 A few observations
  - · Jesus' last words to the disciples: You will receive power (Holy Spirit) THEN you will be my witnesses
    - It's only possible to be a witness with the power of the Holy Spirit
    - It is humbling and comforting (Luke 24:29)
    - · We can be deceived by emotion and entertainment
    - Amos 5:21-23
  - · There is a need for UNITY
    - · Unity in early church was remarkable
    - · Our unity is our witness
  - There is a need for PRAYER
    - · They devoted themselves to prayer
    - · God has called us to a culture of prayer
    - · We want the easy way BUT we have to commit to doing it as a discipline
  - Prayer and unity are prerequisites for the Holy Spirit to move in power
- · 3 immediate steps
  - 1) Set aside time daily to pray (maybe God is asking for more from you in this season)
  - 2) Join us for pre-service prayer (8:30 & 10:30 in the chapel)
  - 3) Set your alarm for 9:30 Monday through Friday and pray for Grace at that time
- Revelation 3:20
  - Prayer = Jesus coming and dwelling in our hearts
  - · Jesus moves us through prayer
