

Sunday November 26, 2023 - "Genesis - Week 10 - Noah: Humility Matters" - Doug Kempton

Key Passages: Genesis 9:18-29, Ruth 1:16, Isaiah 50:11

- · Allow the group to share freely about what stood out to them from the passage or from Sunday's message

Main Ideas

- · Being fascinated isn't enough..the word of God is meant to bring life change deep in our souls
- Genesis 9:18-29 Noah's spent a year and ten days in the ark
 - Noah waited for God's permission to leave
 - First thing he does is worships —> God blesses him and his sons (covenant = no more worldwide floods)
- Noah becomes a farmer (grapes/wine)
 - · Drinking/nakedness always associated with sin
 - When Godly people sin two things happen
 - Overlook/downplay the sin
 - Vilify...all they have done is a sham
 - Godly people still sin...Noah was still talked about as the only perfect person in his generation
- If we ask "How could he do that?", we don't recognize our own propensity to sin
- Ham SAW
 - Saw = actively searching...same as "God saw" (searching/looking
 - Active not passive...Ham's sin was voyeurism
- · The sin of Ham is passed down to one of his sons and his descendants
 - He removed God's blessing from his offspring
 - Noah's curse = prophetic for humanity
 - This was all to help Israel know and remember their history
- In no way does this passage/history give any people permission to oppress or lord over any other
- The ripple effect of sin to multiple generations (Isaiah 50:11 the consequences of unrepentant sin)
- · It's not about bloodline, it's about "faith line"
 - · Who you align your heart with matters
 - Closest circles/friends (Ruth 1:16)
 - Our identity in Christ trumps every other identity...faith not blood
- Story of Noah is all about HUMILITY
 - · Last family of faith in the world
 - 100 years to build boat with no rain in sight...boat with no navigation
 - · Noah's sin is a reminder of our own need for Jesus
- You can't...walk with Jesus, have authentic community, have kingdom impact...without humility
- When we think we can, we are in a dangerous place...flood didn't wash away our propensity to sin

- 6. What is God inviting you into as a result of this message or passage?
