13 For the Lord has chosen Jerusalem; he has desired it for his home. 14 "This is my resting place forever," he said. "I will live here, for this is the home I desired.




<sup>15</sup> I will bless this city and make it prosperous;

17 Here I will increase the power of David; my anointed one will be a light for my people. 18 I will clothe his enemies with shame, but he will be a glorious king."












Bearing God's image and having His indwelling are two different things.
